6.50 p.m.	Years 7 & 8 girls 2100m (3 laps) Years 9 & 10 girls 2100m (3 laps)
7.05pm	Years 7 & 8 boys 2100m (3 laps) Years 9 & 10 boys 2800m (4 laps)
7.20 p.m.	Corporate Challenge "A" race approx. 4500m (4 laps)
7.45 p.m.	Corporate Challenge "B" race approx. 4500m (4 laps)

The Corporate Challenge is split into "A" and "B" races for logistical reasons. Race "A" for runners under 18 min (10K in under 40min); race "B" for all other runners. This will be strictly adhered to. Team results calculated from aggregate of fastest times regardless whether athletes run in the "A" or "B" race
